<b>Description of Duties:</b> Duties include but are limited to: coordinating the preparation and serving of breakfast, lunch, and dinner for approximately 125 students; assisting the food service manager by procuring food items; coordinating storage and rotation of stock; assisting the food service manager by entering data into the computer system to produce accurate reports; helping to ensure that all state accountability forms are accurately completed on a daily, weekly, and/or monthly basis; developing schedules and procedures for sanitation of equipment and facility; conducting facility/equipment sanitation and maintenance inspections; supervising food service employees as assigned; preparing staff work schedules and tasks as assigned; monitoring the quality of meals; observing adherence to meal schedules; and performing other related duties as assigned.

<b>Preferred Qualifications:</b> Preference will be given to applicants who, in addition to meeting the minimum qualifications, possess one or more of the following: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Serv Safe Certification</li> <li>Experience as a supervisor in a commercial food operation (full-service restaurant or institutional kitchen)</li> <li>Completion of a vocational-technical school program in cooking, culinary arts, cooking management, or equivalent in which the management of a full-service cooking operation was the primary focus of the program.</li> <li>Possess American Sign Language (ASL) proficiency at the basic level, or higher as measured by the Sign Language Proficiency Interview (SLPI), ASL Proficiency Interview (ASLPI), or as assessed by qualified GSD staff</li> </ul>
